****Take-Home Instructions****

Before Care

- **DO NOT** work out the day of procedure
- **DO NOT** tan or have sunburned face
- **DO NOT** take Aspirin, Niacin, Vitamin E or Ibuprofen 24hrs before procedure
- No alcohol or caffeine on the day of procedure
- No waxing or tinting 3 days before
- Please note that you will be more sensitive during your menstrual cycle

After Care

- *First day for dry, normal skin*
 - Rinse the eyebrows with warm water and neutral soap, without stretching the skin. Circle gently on the eyebrows until clean skin is felt under the fingertips. After rinsing, you can use Vaseline, or any type of Pantenol, Jecoderm. The first process of rinsing and application should be done half an hour after the treatment. During the day, this process should be repeated 4-5 times. After the last rinsing, before going to sleep over the prepared eyebrows, place transparent folio and fixate with a clean kerchief, sleeping mask, hairband, etc.
- *First day for oily skin*
 - Rinse like with regular skin, but avoid oily creams such as Vaseline, Jecoderm or Pantenol. We recommend Pantenol emulsion, cream or gel. Gel with AD Vitamin can also be used. Rinsing and application is repeated 4-5 times during the first day and this completes the post-treatment process for oily skin.
- *Next 5 days for both skin*
 - Apply a thin layer of cream without rinsing and without putting on foil
- *2-3 weeks after treatment*
 - Avoid the application of powder, makeup, and cream with active ingredients over the eyebrows, exposure to sun, bathing in public water, strong/rigorous exercise with profuse sweating, sauna, solarium, etc.

PLEASE NOTE

- **Eyebrows will appear darker and bolder due to natural scabbing and healing for the first 10 days. This is very common for all permanent cosmetic procedures.**
- The client shall consult a health care practitioner at the first sign of infection or an allergic reaction, and report any diagnosed infection, allergic reaction, or adverse reaction resulting from the tattoo to the artist and to the Texas Department of State Health Services, Drugs and Medical Devices Group, at **1-888-839-6676**.

Permanent make-up **IS NOT** recommended for any clients who are or have:

- Pregnant or nursing
- Diabetic
- Undergoing chemotherapy (consult your doctor)
- Viral infection and/or diseases
- Epilepsy
- A pacemaker or major heart problems
- Had an organ transplant
- Skin irritations or psoriasis near treated area (rashes, sunburn, acne, ect...)
- Sick (cold, flu, etc.)
- Had Botox in the past 2 months
- Used Accutane in the past year

EXPLANATION

- The client is informed in detail by BB-MA about specific risks of eyebrow drawing treatment using microblading technique.
- The following risks are specifically explained to the client:
 - During the treatment, despite the staff's expertise and all the precautionary measures, injury is possible.
 - Despite the application of the most advanced and the top quality pigments, allergic reaction is possible but rare. The client is informed about this and he/she assumes liability.
 - During and after treatment, temporary swelling, redness and/or itching may occur. These symptoms are temporary.
 - Depending on the skin structure after the first treatment, small scabs with loss of drawn hair may occur and color intensity may change. In the first seven days, eyebrows are up to 40% darker and 10-15% thicker. Color reflection depends on the natural skin pigment. The shape is determined according to the face proportions. Symmetry is determined digitally, with closed eyes because of the negative impact of facial expression.
 - The pigment is absorbed differently due to differences in the skin quality; thus, there is no warranty for the treatment success.
 - Depending on the skin structure, it should be noted that changed in the color intensity is possible and that one or more additional treatments will be required.
 - The minimum/maximum duration for eyebrow drawing treatment cannot be determined with certainty, nor can the warranty be given on performed treatment.
 - The first correction is done four weeks after the treatment. For oily skin, it is necessary to perform more corrections.
 - Permanent make-up always leads to the skin injury. Therefore, it's important to carefully and gently nurture your skin after the treatment to allow healing without complications. Inadequate care in healing phase of the skin can lead to poor results and BB-MA cannot be liable for it.
 - Clients have read and understood the **Before/After Care of Microblading** form on how to care for the brows before and after treatment for optimum results. This form is given to clients to take home for future reference.

BB-MA is not liable in the case of improper post-treatment care.
